Everyone else- thanks for making this trip a memorable one, throughout the past four years there isn't a moment I regret, I will miss you all and good luck, you will all succeed.



Speier - We have had some good times. Everyday seeing you always happy just made my day a little better, thanks.



Dad: I hope that you can see all of my accomplishments and I know that you are proud. You have always been my role model. I love you and miss you.



September 11, 2001




